The organization „**HERZEN FÜR EINE NEUE WELT E.V.**“

We are a non-profit organization based in Königstein im Taunus, dedicated to helping socially disadvantaged children and their families in the highlands of the Andes in Peru build an independent future. Our support for self-help is carried out in close cooperation with our partner organization, „Corazones para Perú,“ through the implementation of educational and health programs on-site.

Since our founding in 1998 by Dr. Dieter Arnold (†), we have managed the children’s village „Munaychay,“ which provides a loving home for disadvantaged orphans, including both orphans and social orphans. Additionally, we run the „Santa Rosa“ education center, which offers

educational courses for both our beneficiaries and the rural population of the surrounding area. Over time, our commitment has grown significantly, and we, together with our partner organization, are increasingly involved in the areas of education, health, nutrition, environmental protection, and gender equality through our five support programs.

We finance our expenditures almost exclusively through donations. Each year, we receive support from numerous volunteers and young German volunteers participating in the development policy volunteer service „weltwärts,“ who contribute to our work on-site.



The joint commitment **OF THE ORGANIZATIONS**

„Munaychay“ – **THE CHILDREN’S VILLAGE**

In our children’s village, we provide children with a loving home and comprehensive care. We place special emphasis on education, upbringing, support, and the necessary social and psychological assistance. In addition to disadvantaged orphans, including both orphans and social orphans, we also take in children from remote highland areas who have no access to secondary

schools. Their parents trust us with their children so that they can receive a better education. Our educational concept is based on fostering independence and initiative. The core values we aim to instill in the children and youth are solidarity, cultural identity, reciprocity („AYNI“ – a fundamental value in Andean culture), ethics, and autonomy.

„Santa Rosa“ – **THE EDUCATION CENTER**

The education center consists of various facilities, including a training building, a creative workshop, and the „Santa Rosa“ agricultural center. The training building features a computer center, several training rooms, and a science laboratory. The creative workshop includes a painting room, a music room, a pottery studio, and a weaving room.

The agricultural center contains a carpentry workshop, a sewing room, a guinea pig farm, a beekeeping operation, an oyster mushroom farm, eco-friendly greenhouses and fields, and a nursery. The educational courses offered are aimed at both our beneficiaries and the rural population of the surrounding area.



An Overview of **OUR SUPPORT PROGRAMS**

„LEARNING WITH HEART“

We provide children from disadvantaged families with access to education. This includes offering care, social support, and financial assistance to the families.

„SCHOOL NETWORK“

We support needy schools with materials and promote the exchange and professional development of their teachers. Additionally, we finance a daily balanced school meal.

„EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUTH“

We support young people during their practical or academic training by providing comprehensive assistance in the form of care, social support, and financial aid.

„PERSPECTIVES FOR LIFE“

We are committed to gender equality and support young women in socially disadvantaged situations as well as single mothers in achieving independence. To this end, we offer opportunities for further education.

„HEALTHY LIVING“

We promote the health of children and adults through health campaigns and hygiene training. In cooperation with „Zahnärzte helfen e.V.“ (Dentists Help e.V.), we also provide free medical and dental care at health stations.

- Establishment of the “Munaychay” children’s village for 70 children

- Setting up computer centers in schools
- Improvement of infrastructure

- Creation of new jobs through our support programs
